#### TEACHING ARTISTS

What they can offer to students

Ms. Marcia and Ms. Sarah continue to work as professional dance artists and just wrapped up a very exciting multidisciplinary project with a performance at the Beaverbrook Art Gallery in Fredericton on Saturday, April 30th. They were two of fourteen dance artists from the province who participated in *Isolated Together*; a work that began in 2020 in partnership with the Atlantic Ballet Theatre, Theatre New Brunswick and the Beaverbrook Art Gallery.

Dance educators who still contribute to the art form through new works and collaborations benefit our students in many ways. Two of these have an immediate impact on a dancer's education.

Dance as an art form has been depleted over the years with a focus on competition. At FCSD, we focus on the artistry of dance. Our students are involved in the creative process from a young age. They see and understand how the creation of dance evolves over time; that it's more than just a step and some tricks and that each dancer has something unique to share, to express and how important collaboration is to the process.

The other wonderful benefit is the connection to the professional artistic community. We offer workshops, talks and intensives where students can learn from other artists. Opportunities outside of their dance classes enhance their experience and help grow versatile dancers.
